

## Requirements for articles in the journal «Labour and social security law»

An article for consideration should be written in Russian, Belarusian or English languages and include next requirements:

- 1) UDC code;
- 2) title of the article;
- 3) surname and initials of author (authors);
- 4) summary (100–150 words) on Russian and English language;
- 5) key words (5–10 words) on Russian and English language;
- 6) introduction;
- 7) principal part, which describes issues under consideration;
- 8) conclusion, which includes clearly defined findings;

9) list of cited sources executed according to actual requirements of Higher Attestation Commission of Republic of Belarus (articles 46–52 of instructions approved by enactment of Higher Attestation Commission of Republic of Belarus February 28, 2014 № 3).

### Typography of the article

The article capacity should be 14 000–16 000 characters with gaps. The text should be written in Times New Roman font, 14 pt, one and a half line spacing, full justification. References of cited sources are placed at the end of phrase, are numbered in accordance with order of citation in the text and are given in brackets: [1, p. 23]. Indentation – 1,25 cm. The title is written in capital letters, in bold, center alignment. The initials and surname of the author (in the presence of scholastic degree, academic title, office and job) are written on the next line.

An author's note on a separate page (file) is presented along with the article. Author – citizen of the Republic of Belarus should present information in **Russian, Belarusian and English languages**. Author – citizen of other states presents information in Russian and English languages.

The author's note should include next information:

- 1) author's surname, name, middle name (in full);
- 2) scholastic degree, academic title;
- 3) office and job (in full and abbreviated);
- 4) article's title;
- 5) mailing address with postal code, e-mail and phone number (with dialing code).

The article should be presented in **electronic form** to e-mail: [ctp.minsk@tut.by](mailto:ctp.minsk@tut.by) (signed "Paper"). One copy of the article of the author from Belarus should be additionally presented on paper to an editorial office: 220099, Belarus, Minsk, Kazintsa St. 21/3, Room 510 (with mark "Scientific research department").

### Condition of article publication in journal «Labour and social security law» and ethics

The editorial office accepts the articles for publication, which haven't been published yet, exclusive rights to which have not been transferred to other persons, which scientific level is appropriate to the journal. A handwriting of the article will not be returned to the author, even in case of failure of publication. Journal's editorial board executes scientific editing and review of the article with members of editorial council, then changes are agreed with the author.

Authors without science degree should present a review, which necessarily includes review's surname, name, middle name (fully), scholastic degree, academic title, office and job.

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
